# Scramble Fundraising Event

Date: Saturday, March 23, 2013

**Tournament Format:** Five (5) Game Event. Each game will be a different format as follows;

**Game One (Best Ball)**-2 members of each team pair up. The game will be handicapped using the lower handicap of each pairing within the team. Bowler 1 throws their 1st ball on the left lane. If they throw a strike the frame is over and the strike is counted. If they do not throw a strike, Bowler 2 throws their 1st ball on the right lane. If they throw a strike the frame is over and the strike counts. If both bowlers fail to throw a strike, the team must choose which bowler will finish the frame. That is the frame that is counted. The game continues with the bowlers alternating lanes,



**Game Two: (Scotch Doubles)**-2 members of each team pair up with a different partner than in game 1. The game will be handicapped using 1/2 of the team's total handicap. The team plays a regular game with each member alternating shots. Bowler 1 throws the 1st ball, bowler 2 throws the 2nd ball, bowler 1 the 3rd ball and so on throughout the game. ie. Bowler 1 throws a strike in frame 1, Bowler 2 throws and leaves the left corner. Bowler 1 makes the spare. Bowler 2 throws the 1st ball of frame 3, etc.



**Game Three:(3-6-9)**-Each bowler plays their own game and each individual handicap is counted from here on out. In 3-6-9 each bowler is given a strike in frames 3, 6 & 9. All other frames are played under normal rules.



**Game 4: (No Tap)**-If on the 1st ball of the frame the bowler knocks down all but the left or the right corner, a strike is counted and the frame is over. The rest of the game is played under normal rules.



**Game 5:(Headpin Revenge)**-If on the 1st ball, the bowler punches the headpin or punches the headpin and carries a 2 pin on a kick back, a strike is counted and the frame is over. The rest of the game is played under normal rules.
