Appreciation Evening for Barry MacAdam

On Saturday September 29th, there was a surprise event for Barry MacAdam to appreciate the 40 years that he has put into coaching within the Ottawa Valley. The event night at the Merivale Lanes was organized by Rob Gadde, Matthew Leonard and Spencer Murray as they represented Barry achievements from the past, current open bowler and YBC bowlers.

Over 100 people attended the Appreciation Night and got a chance to see some of Barry's memorabilia in the form of medals, honours received (plaques) and shirts; including a 'Berry' MacAdam shirt. Some of the shirts were signed by the players he had coached in that particular year. Attendees shared a number of pictures of teams that he has coached, pictures of Barry in various costumes and others; these were put up in a continuous slide show.

One of the things he is most proud of is winning medals in the Youth Challenge at the Ontario Winter games, 5 so far with two of them gold. He also fondly remembers taking the Senior Boys Orleans YBC team to the Nationals in 2017 that was held in Gatineau Quebec, which is being part of the National Capital Region home for him.

After some stories honouring Barry from the different eras, he was presented with a number of gifts. A small 50/50 was done with the proceeds going to an Animal Shelter of his choice. Barry is an ardent supporter of rescue shelters.

Barry has coached in YBC programs at the Preston Lanes, Kent Lanes and currently is helping in Orleans. Two years ago, marked the last year that Barry bowled in a league, on Wednesday Night in Orleans, and his team won record scores for a 5-man team with a 1395 single and a 3750 triple; what a way to top a bowling career.
