We also had eleven 900 series bowled ranging from a 901 to a high of 950 which was shot by Melissa Llewellyn from Central Ontario.

In Ladies' team play, Central Ontario defeated Ontario Durham for the Gold 7 to 1. This was achieved with two rookie bowlers on the team.

In Men's team play, Middlesex Elgin pushed Metro Toronto to two games before Metro secured the gold and claimed victory 6 to 2.

In the Mixed division, Hamilton defeated Central Ontario 5 to 3 to claim the gold medal by a narrow margin of 14 pins. This team also had two rookies competing.

It was encouraging to see that we had 33 female rookies and 36 male rookies playing in the Open and Senior Open this year. Two rookie females and two rookie males are going to the Nationals this year in B.C.

At the Senior Open this year, Niagara Peninsula were victorious defeating Huronia in the final match 6 to 2.

A new record score was achieved in the Senior Open with Ottawa's Joanne Nadeau's high 5 game total of 1,346 surpassing Kushal Murphy of York Simcoe previous record of 1,339.

In the Ladies singles stepladder, Joanne Nadeau from Ottawa Valley won the ladies single title for the fourth time. In the men's singles stepladder Ken Oldridge from Western Ontario ran the stepladder and defeated Serge Lalonde from Ottawa Valley twice to capture the gold medal.
