Zone & DC Financial Agreements

If you haven't already done so, a copy of your Financial MUST be submitted to the Provincial Office. These Agreements are a condition under which local Zone and Decentralized Associations maintain their charter as members of the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association.

Copies forwarded to the Provincial Office **MUST BE DATED** and provide the names of both the Zone and DC Associations which are parties to the Agreement. They must be legibly signed by the Presidents of all Associations, which are parties to the Agreement. **(Members of the same family cannot sign both sides of the Agreement).**

Respect in Sport – Limited Time Free Access Licenses

We were notified by the C5PBA that the Bowling Federation of Canada has secured funding to provide Safe Sport training. There are approximately 960 free access licenses available and they are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

We trust that all coaches who coach at the Provincial or National Level of the Youth Challenge took advantage of these free access licenses. To be eligible to coach at the above Youth events, you are required to have the "Commit to Kids" and "Respect in Sport" accreditations.
