



## Coaching Update

### Commit to Kids for Coaches eLearning module

The 2.5 hour online training provides coaches, sport volunteers and staff with practical information to help them enhance child and youth safety in sport. The goal of the training is to empower coaches/staff/volunteers and support the great work they are doing with child and youth athletes. The Commit to Kids for Coaches online training addresses the importance of understanding boundaries, sexual misconduct and reporting inappropriate behavior. Users will receive a certificate of completion and 3 NCCP PD points toward maintenance of certification.

The cost of the Commit to Kids for Coaches online training is \$9 per person (no tax) until June 30, 2020 (regular cost is \$12). Discount will be applied at checkout. To purchase the training, visit <https://protectchildren.ca/en/get-involved/online-training/commit-to-kids-for-coaches/>. The training does not need to be completed by June 30, 2020, just purchased by this date in order to receive the discounted price. Once purchased, the training is valid for a two month period.
