Appointment of 3 New O5PBA Board Members

The following letter was sent out by John Cresswell to all Zone and DC Presidents on August 8, 2017.

"As was passed at the 2017 AGM this past June at Fern Resort, the Board of Directors was increased from 9 to 12 members. This process will be implemented over the next three seasons to get the elected Board from the current 9 to 12. It was also approved that the Board would fill the unelected positions via appointment on a yearly basis.

The Strategic and Action Plans of the O5PBA were also approved during the same meeting. The Board has evaluated the strengths and weaknesses of the current elected positions and feel that the recruitment and inclusion of youth (19 to 30) and females to our boards (Provincial, Zone and DC) are priority items to not only us, but the Ontario Government as well.

Towards this end, the Board is seeking your input and assistance in identifying individuals that match these criteria. Please review your current volunteers and members in your local association, if you have anyone who fits into the two key areas and would be interested in working at the Provincial level; please submit a list of potential candidates from your area. Prospects do not have to be working on your current boards, but do need to be members in good standing with the O5PBA.

The next scheduled Board conference call meeting is September 13, 2017, and we will be reviewing names submitted from the field. As such I ask that you submit your potential candidates to me on or before September 12, 2017."

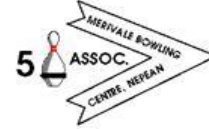
