ANTI-DOPING POLICY

The Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association (O5PBA) recognizes that the use of doping substances or doping methods to enhance one's performance is fundamentally wrong and is damaging to the overall impact of 5 pin bowling. The misuse of drugs can be harmful to an athlete's health and, also indirectly impacts other athletes competing in bowling. Doping can severely damage the integrity and value of the sport of bowling.

To ensure that we maintain the integrity of the sport of bowling, the O5PBA accepts and adopts the policies developed by the Centre for Ethics in Sport as endorsed by Sport Canada.

The O5PBA acknowledges the role of the World Anti-Doping Agency in setting global standards and coordinating anti-doping worldwide and implementing all portions of the World Anti-Doping Program.

The Canadian Anti-Doping Program is administered on behalf of the World Anti-Doping Agency by the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport, and the O5PBA respects the designated authority of the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport and all anti-doping matters.

Documentation on anti-doping rules and an up-to-date list of banned substances is available upon request from the Centre of Ethics in Sport.

This policy includes all individuals engaged in the activity of bowling, including, but not limited to: athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, directors, officers, team managers, team captains, administrators and employees.
