1 - The Code of Conduct for all Ontario 5 Pin Provincial Championships is as follows:
Bowlers and/or Coaches shall not display conduct, which can be deemed unsportsmanlike.
Unsportsmanlike Conduct shall be defined as, but is not limited to: i) Using the bowling ball in an expression of emotion by bouncing the ball or striking other balls on the rack. ii) Throwing balls in an extreme lofting manner in an underhand or overhand motion. iii) Loud, abusive and/or derogatory language. iv) Using portions of one's body in an expression of emotion, such as kicking of ball racks or other establishment equipment, throwing of furniture or other establishment equipment, striking of walls, posts, etc. v) Bowlers are prohibited from using another bowler's personal bowling ball(s) without permission from the owner.
Any bowler or coach in violation of this conduct, as determined by the Judge of Play or the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee, shall be subject to the following:
First Offence: Any Bowler and/or Coach who violates said rule shall receive a Tournament Warning Form from the Tournament Director or designated replacement. This form will be signed by both the bowler and the coach. The Provincial Association shall duly record the offender's name as a first time offender. This formal warning will be in effect for a two (2) year period ending July 31 of the second year.
Repeat Offences: Bowlers and/or Coaches who have already received a Tournament Warning Form and have been reported to the Provincial Association, on a second violation of said rule, within the two year period, shall be removed from the tournament and be liable for suspension of membership.
Any Bowler and/or Coach who receives a Tournament Warning Form may appeal the offence, by submitting in writing to the Secretary of the Corporation, a request to have their appeal heard.
PLEASE NOTE: THIS ALSO INCLUDES ANY BANQUETS OR RECEPTIONS HOSTED BY THE 05PBA.
2 - The Dress Code for all Ontario 5 Pin Provincial Championships is as follows:
All participants must wear shirts with collars in their registered Zone Association colours with a logo identifying the Association they represent. Participants will present themselves in a neat and clean appearance. No cut-offs, jeans or denim. All clothing must cover the "bottoms area". Individuals on a team may wear a different length style bottom. Teams should wear a consistent colour or pattern. Hats, caps or headgear of any kind are prohibited unless worn for medical or religious reasons.
A commercially made "Coach" pin must be worn on the front or sleeve and be visible at all times, unless the word "Coach" is embroidered on the shirt sleeve or chest. The first offence is a uniform violation. Subsequent violations during the same event, is removal from the tournament.
Any participant not conforming to the dress code may not be permitted to compete in the event as determined by the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee. <u>A fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) will be levied against each <i>PARTICIPANT</i> not conforming to the dress code.</u>

The following waiver of all claims, release from all liability, assumption of all risks and other terms of this agreement are entered into by me (the "Participant") with and for the benefit of the **Ontario Five Pin Bowlers Association**, its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, coaches, officials, business operators, agents and site property owners or Occupiers (the "Organization"). Occupiers is defined in accordance with the definition of Occupiers contained in the Occupiers Liability legislation applicable to the Province or Territory in which the Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization.

- 1. "Athletic Activities" includes but is not limited to contact and non-contact sports, fitness activities, personal training instruction and activities, use of facilities, and fitness programs and services provided to the Participant by the Organization.
- 2. I am aware that there are inherent and significant risks ("Risks") associated with the participation in Athletic Activities. I am aware that those Risks include but are not limited to the potential for serious personal injury caused by any event or any condition of the facility or equipment where Athletic Activities are provided by the Organization, and health risks such as transient light-headedness, fainting, abnormal blood pressure, chest discomfort, muscle cramps or soreness, and nausea. I understand the Risks are relative to my own state of fitness and health (physical, mental and emotional), and to the awareness, care and skill with which I conduct myself while participating in Athletic Activities.
- 3. I freely accept and fully assume all responsibility for all Risks and possibilities of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from my participation in Athletic Activities.
