SUBJECT: ZONE/DC ASSOCIATION FINANCIAL AGREEMENTS

With the 2016-17 bowling season underway, the Provincial Board of Directors want to remind you that all Zone and Decentralized Associations **MUST** file a copy of your Zone and Decentralized Association Financial Agreements with the Provincial Office.

The annual filing of these current agreements is a condition under which Local Zone and Decentralized Associations maintain their Charter as a member organization of the Ontario and Canadian 5 Pin Bowlers' Associations.

If you have not already done so, please give your immediate attention to the negotiation of your Zone/Decentralized Association Financial Agreements for the 2016-17 bowling season, and then forward a copy of each to the Provincial Office.

Copies forwarded to the Provincial Office **MUST BE DATED**, and must provide the names of both the Zone and Decentralized Associations which are parties to the Agreement, and must be legibly signed by the Presidents of all Associations which are parties to the Agreement (**Members of the same family cannot sign both sides of the agreement**).

A working copy of this suggested agreement is enclosed for your information. Please note that this is a "**SAMPLE AGREEMENT ONLY**". You may use your own form if there is one in existence, or you may wish to use the sample provided.

Incentive points will be awarded to those Associations who submit their Zone/DC Association Financial Agreements to the Provincial Office on or before **NOVEMBER 11, 2016**.

Please Note: Zone Associations that do not have DC's must complete the attached Zone Agreement Declaration Form to qualify for incentive points.

Please feel free to contact the Provincial Office should you encounter any difficulty in completing the negotiation of a Financial Agreement for the 2016-17 bowling season, or if any disputes over interpretation arise during the season.
