

SENIORS MAIL-O-GRAPHIC TOURNAMENT

F O R M A T

The Seniors Mail-O-Graphic tournament consists of two (2) steps:

- **LEAGUE ROUND RESULTS**
- **PROVINCIAL RESULTS**

GENERAL RULES

1. Open to all Sanctioned Senior's leagues, who's bowlers are all **50 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER** as of **DECEMBER 31, 2011**.
2. Entry fee for this tournament will be \$4.00 per bowler, of which \$0.50 is to be submitted to the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers Association. The balance is to be used by the league for the winners as they see fit.
3. Bowlers who are members of two (2) or more leagues may use their scores from each league to qualify.
4. This event is a pins-over-average tournament.
5. League Secretaries, or their designate, will be responsible for keeping track of the monthly winners.
6. League rules will apply in the qualifying round.
7. In the case of any dispute, or interpretation of any rule, the decision of the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee shall be final.

LEAGUE RULES

1. Every bowler will have the opportunity to qualify each week as a Single Game, Two Game or Three Game pins over average winner during regular league play between **OCTOBER 16, 2011** and **FEBRUARY 11, 2012**. **Two Game winners are for those leagues that bowl only two (2) games per week.**
2. League Secretary will determine the highest pins over average single game, two game or three game winners (man or woman). Then on the winners report form please include the bowlers average (the week that he/she bowled the game) their score and their pins over average total.
3. Bowlers may qualify more than once for the Monthly Awards.
4. In the event of a tie for any category, each bowlers name may be submitted.

5. Bowlers must use their average from the league in which they belong, with a **minimum of twelve (12) games** having been bowled.

PROVINCIAL ROUND

1. The Provincial Round shall be bowled during the week of **MARCH 4-10, 2012** during league play. All monthly winners in both the Single game, Two game and Three game category from each Zone/DC will be eligible to compete in the Provincial Round mail in.
2. All bowlers competing in the Provincial Round mail in must have bowled a minimum of twenty-one (21) games during the 2011-12 bowling season up to and including **FEBRUARY 11, 2012**.
3. Final results must be submitted to the O5PBA no later than **MARCH 26, 2012**.
4. In the event of a tie for any of the winning spots, each participant (winner) will receive the same award.
5. Scores and averages of winners will be authenticated and checked thoroughly. Any falsification or misrepresentation of scores or averages, knowingly or unknowingly, shall result in automatic disqualification.
