## HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

The banquet on WEDNESDAY, MAY 11, 2016 will be held immediately following bowling in the Lounge at NEB's Fun World. Bowlers are invited to attend the banquet FREE OF CHARGE. Awards will be presented and top winners will be announced at the banquet.

If you wish to bring a guest(s) to the banquet and awards presentations, the cost will be $\$ 25.00$ per ticket (HST included). Banquet tickets will only be available if ordered on your Bowler Information Form. In addition, all guest banquet tickets must be pre-paid as all meals have to be GUARANTEED by our Association.

PLEASE NOTE: AS WAS PASSED AT OUR 2004 ANNUAL CONVENTION, ANY BOWLER INDICATING THEY WILL BE ATTENDING THE BANQUET ON THEIR BOWLER INFORMATION FORM AND DO NOT ATTEND, WILL BE PERSONALLY INVOICED FOR THE COST OF THE DINNER.

## AVERAGE CLARIFICATION

All bowlers competing in the Provincial Championships must have bowled a minimum of twenty-one (21) games during the 2015-2016 bowling season up to and including MARCH 13, 2016, and must use the following criteria for determining averages:
a) AVERAGE BOOK: Bowlers must use their rolling average as recorded in the Average Book or on the O5PBA website, and as established in any league in Ontario.
b) NON-AVERAGE BOOK: Bowlers with no rolling average in the Average Book or on the O5PBA website, must use the highest of the following as determined by the Provincial Office:

Use their highest league average up to and including MARCH 13, 2016 (highest average if a bowler bowls in two (2) or more leagues), and as established in any league in Ontario.

- OR -

Use their average based on the median between their highest league average up to and including MARCH 13, 2016, and the average based on the twenty-one (21) games (seven weeks) leading up to MARCH 13, 2016.

## Average Calculation:

Average as of specified average date: 186
Average over last 21 games (seven weeks): 199 ( 4191 pinfall divided by 21 games)
199 minus $186=13$ divided in half $=6.5 \ldots \ldots \ldots .186+6=192$
Average for Provincial Championships: 192
PLEASE NOTE: BANK SCORES SHOULD NOT BE USED TO CALCULATE A BOWLER'S AVERAGE AS NO GAMES SHOULD BE COUNTED MORE THAN ONCE. (SEE SCORES OF OCT. 25-15 IN EXAMPLE SHOWN ABOVE)
c) All bowlers not in the Average Book must provide the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association with an original or a photocopy of their Individual Average Sheet. The average sheet must be obtained from all leagues they bowl in, and must show scores bowled in all games from the opening of the 2015-2016 bowling season with a minimum of twenty-one (21) games bowled up to and including MARCH 13, 2016. A hand-copied facsimile of this average sheet is not acceptable. If you cannot get a photocopy, send the original to the Provincial Office and we will photocopy it and return the original to you immediately.

Please Note: Bowlers who are not listed in the Average Book or on the O5PBA Website are required to submit copies of their Individual Average Sheet(s). The Average Sheet(s) must be submitted with the "Bowler Information Form".

## ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF CODE OF CONDUCT AND DRESS CODE FORM

Attached to the Bowler Information Form is an Acknowledgement of Code of Conduct and Dress Code Form. Each participant MUST complete and sign this form to acknowledge they understand and agree to abide by the dress code as outlined below:

All bowlers must wear shirts with collars in their registered Zone Association colours with a logo identifying the Association the bowler represents. Bowlers must wear straight hemmed bottom dress slacks, dress shorts, skirts, skorts or capris. Individuals on a team may wear a different length style bottom. (The skirts, skorts or dress shorts may not be shorter than just below the fingertips when placing your arms at your side). Cotton pants will be permitted provided they are not faded, have no rips, tears or studs on them and have no slits up the side of them. Jeans, harem, spandex, leggings, stirrups, sweatpants, cargo pants or warm-up pants of any kind are prohibited. No pants/slacks with external pockets on the sides will be accepted. Hats, caps or headgear of any kind are prohibited unless worn for medical or religious reasons.

Any bowler not conforming to the dress code may not be permitted to compete in the event as determined by the Ontario 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Tournament Committee. A fine of fifty dollars (\$50.00) will be levied against each BOWLER not conforming to the dress code.

This form MUST be returned to the Provincial Office as part of your Bowler Information Form. Failure to sign this form may result in not being permitted to compete in the event.

Please contact your Local Association to arrange for your bowling shirt.

Also attached to the Bowler Information Form is an Acknowledgement of Risk and Release of Liability Form. In order to ensure our Association of liability coverage, our insurance company has insisted that an Acknowledgement of Risk and Release of Liability Form be signed by ALL PARTICIPANTS in our Provincial Championships.

Please read the form carefully and initial the box after reading and understanding the statements and conditions. Upon completion of the form please print and sign your name. This form MUST also be returned to the Provincial Office as part of your Bowler Information Form. Bowlers who do not complete and sign the form will not be allowed to bowl. This is an action that may seem drastic but is necessary for the well being of your Association.

You will be competing for merchandise prizes at the Provincial Championships. The Provincial Championships will consist of three (3) games and will be based on a pins-over-average format. Winners will be declared in Men's and Ladies' Singles for both the Senior and Junior-Senior Division.
